

Smile Makeover

You are dreaming of your new smile and you do not know what to expect: Here are some key steps in our protocol :

During the first session we always start with photographs and an impression of the two arches.

The plaster models that will be made will allow the dental technician to create the dental volume that will put your smile in value, neither too prominent nor too discreet, the ideal smile.

During your second session we will apply on your teeth a temporary resin that will project the dental volume created by the technician. This will allow you to have a glimpse of your new smile. This assembly, temporary, can sometimes be maintained a few days time to collect the impressions of your entourage.

If you like your new smile, **the third session** will be devoted to preparing your teeth to accommodate the future restorations. Provisional veneers, based on the model of the final volume, will be realized to ensure the aesthetics in the interval of the manufacture.

We always follow the rules of minimally invasive dentistry that dictate a minimum preparation in order to maintain existing dental volumes.

The preparation of the teeth is dependent on the desired veneers and the spatial configuration.

Everything is subject to compromise. No prep restorations can not be expected to produce the same result as prep veneers. It is the same for the bonding durability.

Preparations of 0.5 mm up to 1 mm in the context of large variations and which, for the most part, will only concern tooth enamel will be considered minimally invasive.



Do not hesitate to question your practitioner before giving your consent. There is no return possible once the teeth have been prepared. The first two diagnostic sessions should answer all your questions.

The fourth session is often a test session. It allows to evaluate if the final product created by the technician matches with the request of the patient. If the veneers need to be modified then the provisional ones will be used again in the meanwhile.

The last session is finally devoted to bonding the veneers on your teeth so your new smile becomes real and permanent. Bonding uses composite resins. There are no prosthetic cements and therefore no risk of having a bad taste in your mouth even several years after completion.

If these few lines have reassured you about your decision, go ahead, the result will be incredible.

If what you read previously makes you ask more questions : That's the purpose. A smile makeover is something to consider properly and especially to understand. It clearly responds to a cosmetic demand that often involves, when the teeth have to undergo a preparation, a consequence related decision.
